For the Food Pantry:

- ♦ Call the office or see our webpage for the most current Top Needs list as well as a PDF of the types of food our pantry most needs.
- ♦ Non-perishable goods (no glass containers, please!)
- ♦ Perishable, but non-expired foods, such as garden produce, dairy, meat
- ♦ Personal items – full and travel size (shampoo, toothpaste/brushes, etc.)
- ♦ Paper products (Kleenex, TP, towels, etc.)
- ♦ Laundry Detergent
- ♦ Dish Soap
- ♦ Diapers, esp. sizes 4-6
- ♦ Paper grocery bags
- ♦ Egg Cartons

For the Clothing Program:

- ♦ In-Season clothing; new or gently used
- ♦ Blankets and Sheets
- ♦ Clothing Racks

For Household Goods Program:

- ♦ Kitchenware (especially dishes/glassware in sets, pots/pans, *no electrical appliances, please*)
- ♦ Blankets (*no wool or electric blankets, please!*)
- ♦ Sheets (Twin - Queen)
- ♦ Shower liners, rings and curtains
- ♦ Towels (bath, hand, and washcloths)

For School Supply Program:

We especially need school supplies during July and August as we prepare for our Pre-School Year drive. However, we are **ALWAYS in need of the TI-30 Solar-powered Calculators.**

For the Good Samaritan Program:

- ♦ Pre-paid long distance phone cards
- ♦ Pre-paid gas cards
- ♦ Pre-paid laundry cards
- ♦ Paper products, and read to eat microwaveable food.
- ♦ New backpacks and school supplies
- ♦ Gift certificates to area grocery and department stores, and restaurants
